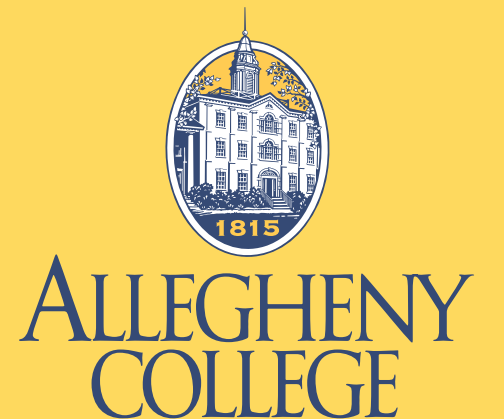


LEARN TO THINK BIG, ASK QUESTIONS, AND WONDER OUTSIDE
