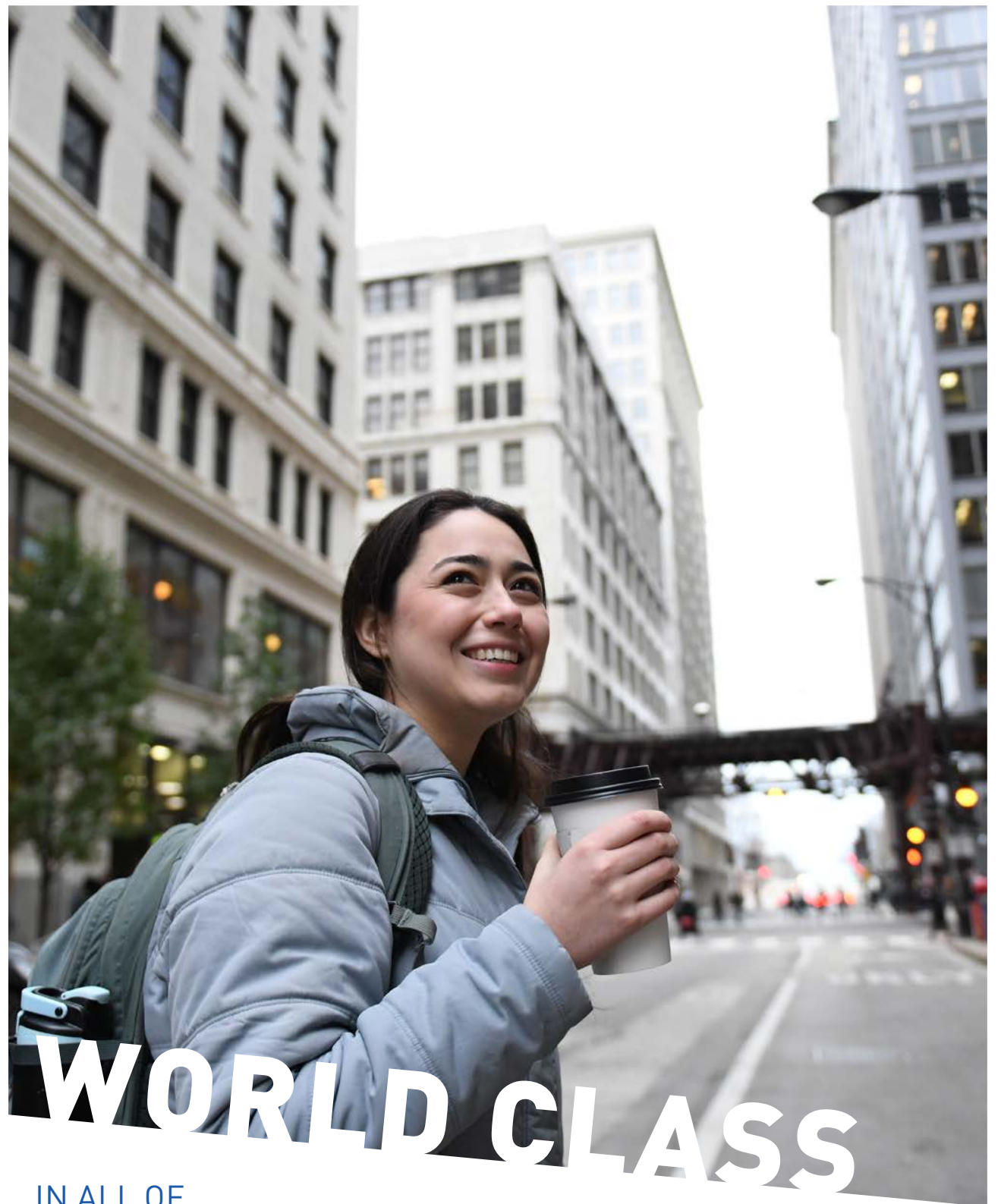

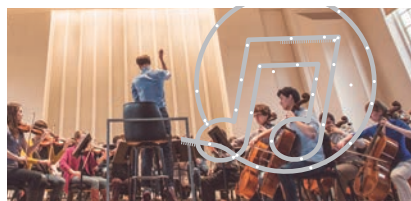

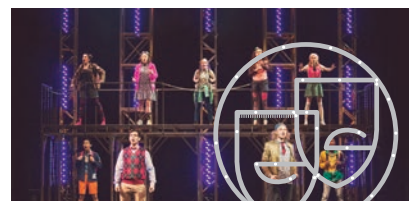

## FINANCING YOUR DEPAUL DEGREE AND INVESTING IN YOUR FUTURE.

There are two types of aid: **gift aid** (money you don't pay back), which includes merit-based scholarships and awards and need-based grants, and **self-help**, which includes work-study and loans.

### DEPAUL SCHOLARSHIPS

Freshmen admitted for the fall term are automatically considered for scholarships based on high school academic achievement. There is not a separate application. Academic scholarships may be renewed for up to 12 consecutive quarters; recipients must maintain good academic standing.

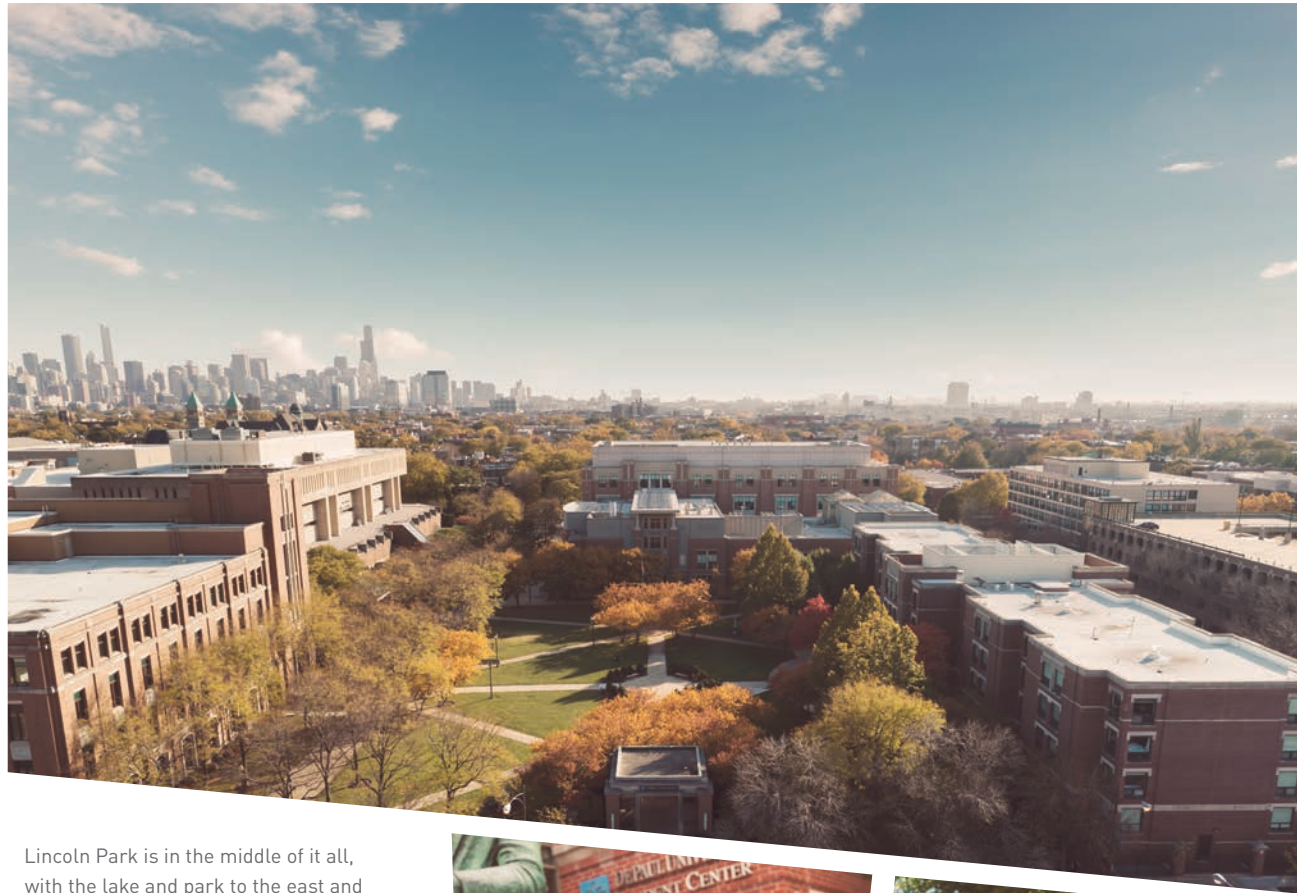

High-achieving first-year undergraduate students are admitted simultaneously to the College of Liberal Arts and Social Sciences or the College of Communication, and the College of Law. Students complete their first three years in the College that hosts their BA program and their final three years in the College of Law.
